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TEA INDUSTRY'S PERFORMANCE IN 2020 & PROSPECTS FOR 2021

TEA INDUSTRY 2020 IN RETROSPECT

2020 will no doubt go down in history as one of the most challenging years with the Covid-19 pandemic changing the world in many ways. The Sri Lankan tea industry was no exception as its world-famous outcry system of auctioning tea having a 137-year-old history was changed to a digital system virtually overnight.


Once again, the tea industry showed its resilience by rising to the occasion in digitalising the auction in a very short period of time, which facilitated the uninterrupted sale of tea. This initiative was spearheaded by the Colombo Tea Traders' Association (CTTA) and supported by the Colombo Brokers' Association (CBA) and its technical partner CICRA Holdings. Concurrently, many other auction centers around the world too adopted and changed to the methodology of selling tea digitally, transforming the character of the 'Tea Men.'

The Corona virus outbreak left the global economy looking bleak, with likely recessions in many developed economies across the world. Whilst there was some hope of recovery in the 2nd half of the year, the continuation of the pandemic shattered all hopes, which meant the uncertainty continued. Consequently, lower fiscal revenues and higher public expenditure placed many countries in a slump.

Notwithstanding the gloom and doom – tea, with its wellness properties and considered to be a cheap beverage, gathered widespread interest globally which helped the wheels of the tea industry to keep turning.

Consequent to the lower volumes that were harvested from around the latter part of 2019, prices were edging up on the previous year's levels, which was propelled quite sharply following the pandemic, where consumers around the world went on a panic buying spree of food items, of which, tea was no exception. Consequently, many importers remained desperate for urgent shipments, which led to strong buying at the Colombo Tea Auctions.

Post Covid-19 impact is amply demonstrated in the following graph.



Global tea production fell in 2020 after a continuous increase for many years as weather conditions have been mixed and in many major tea producing countries. Kenya would be the only exception where production has increased quite significantly and largely reflects a cyclical recovery after a drought induced decline in 2019.

Indian production was badly impacted by the Corona virus pandemic with restrictions on tea plucking during the shutdown of economic activity in March-April and thereafter the heavy rain, resulting in flooding in most parts of Northern India contributed to an estimated 15% fall in production in 2020. This could be quite significant particularly considering that almost 80% of India's production is absorbed by its domestic demand.

INTRODUCTION

01ST QUARTER-2020

Production

Sri Lankan tea production declined to a 53.1 M/Kgs from a 73.4 M/Kgs during the corresponding period in 2019 (a decline of 27%).

Auction Averages/Prices

Total auction average of Rs. 594.81 showed an increase of Rs. 9.51 compared to Rs. 585.30 recorded during the 1st quarter in 2019. Mid Growns appreciated Rs. 9.86 quarter on quarter, whilst Low Growns showed a gain of Rs. 19.51. However, High Growns recorded a decline of Rs. 19.61.

Exports

Tea Exports totalled 59.5 M/Kgs, recording a decline of 14.1 M/Kgs vis-à-vis 73.6 M/Kgs during the corresponding quarter in 2019. Earnings from tea exports of Rs. 49.2 billion records a deficit of Rs. 13.2 billion vis-à-vis Rs. 62.4 billion during January-March 2019. Overall FOB values too declined to Rs. 826.39 in 2020 from Rs. 847.57 in 2019.

2ND QUARTER-2020

Production

Total tea production of 75.3 M/Kgs recorded a deficit of 10.1 M/Kgs vis-à-vis 85.4 M/Kgs during April-June 2019. During this period, Low Growns showed the steepest negative variance of 7.2 M/Kgs followed by negative variances of 1.5 M/Kgs and 0.6 M/Kgs from the High and Medium Grown regions respectively.

Auction Averages/Prices

All elevations recorded a sharp increase in the auction prices following the panic buying spree post Covid-19. In the second quarter of 2019/2020, Low Growns gained Rs. 136.38 followed by High Growns Rs. 109.93, Medium Growns Rs. 108.99 and the total Colombo auction average by Rs. 120.93. Furthermore, a significant appreciation on prices quarter on quarter – High Growns Rs. 54.43, Medium Growns Rs. 57.89, Low Growns Rs. 76.38 and the overall average by Rs. 62.98.

Exports

Tea exports totalled 64.5 M/Kgs, recording a deficit of 7.0 M/Kgs vis-à-vis 71.5 M/Kgs during the corresponding quarter in 2019. Export earnings totalled Rs. 56.8 billion, recording a decline in earnings of Rs. 2.6 billion compared to Rs. 59.4 billion in 2019. FOB value of Rs. 831.11 recorded an increase of Rs. 50.17 vis-à-vis Rs. 881.28 in corresponding quarter in 2019.

3RD QUARTER-2020

Production

Total production showed some recovery and totalled 72.0 M/Kgs during the quarter under review, with a marginal deficit of 2.0 M/Kgs when compared to the 74.0 M/Kgs harvested during the corresponding quarter in 2019. End 3rd quarter deficit 31.0 M/Kgs (13%).

Auction Averages/Prices

Consequent to greater stability and availability, both in Sri Lanka and globally, auction prices began to take a correction commencing around end May and well into the 3rd quarter. Therefore, whilst auction prices continued to reflect a significant increase over its corresponding prices in 2019, 3rd quarter auction averages showed a fairly significant decline on the 2nd quarter auction averages.

Exports

Tea exports totalled 74.2 M/Kgs marginally behind 75.9 M/Kgs in 2019. Export earnings Rs. 64.4 billion vis-à-vis Rs. 60.6 billion in 2019. End 3rd quarter 2020, tea exports totalled 198.2 M/Kgs vis-à-vis 221.0 M/Kgs in 2019, a deficit of 22.8 M/Kgs. Export earnings totalled Rs. 170.5 billion vis-à-vis Rs. 182.5 billion, which records a deficit of Rs. 12.0 billion in earnings.

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4th QUARTER-2020

Production

Total production of 77.4 M/Kgs during the quarter, recording a significant gain of 10.2 M/Kgs vis-à-vis the corresponding period in 2019. **Annual Production** totalled 278.8 M/Kgs against 300.1 M/Kgs in 2019, which records a decline of 21.3 M/Kgs (approximately 7%).

Auction Averages/Prices

The total auction average moved up significantly from a Rs. 615.80 in the third quarter to Rs. 643.15 in the fourth quarter. An increase of Rs. 27.35 quarter-on-quarter.

High Growns increased sharply from Rs. 528.70 in the 3rd quarter to Rs. 622.09 in the 4th quarter (An increase of Rs. 93.39 per kg). Mid Growns which increased from Rs. 535.16 in the 3rd quarter to Rs. 577.10 in the 4th quarter (An increase of Rs. 41.94 per kg). Low Growns increased from Rs. 664.07 in the 3rd quarter to Rs. 667.84 in the 4th quarter (An increase of Rs. 3.77 per kg).

Refer **Table 1** below for a comparison of Colombo Auction prices (Sri Lankan Rupees and US Dollars) for the period 2017, 2018, 2019 and 2020.

Interestingly, whilst the rupee prices have shown a significant increase in 2020, 2017 records the highest auction averages in US Dollar terms.

Exports

Tea exports for the period under review totalled 67.2 M/Kgs against 71.5 M/Kgs during the corresponding period in 2019, achieving a total annual export volume of 265.5 M/Kgs against 292.6 in 2019. A deficit of 27.1 M/Kgs.

Export Revenue

Export earnings totalled Rs. 59.6 billion vis-à-vis Rs. 58.1 billion in 2019. Thereby, total export earnings in 2020 – Rs. 230.1 billion against Rs. 240.6 billion in 2019. A negative variance of Rs. 10.5 billion.

Overall average unit FOB price during the quarter increased from Rs. 868.70 in the third quarter to Rs. 886.23 in the fourth quarter. An increase of Rs. 17.53. Total annual FOB value (January to December 2020) Rs. 866.70 vis-à-vis Rs. 822.25 in 2019. An increase of Rs. 44.45.



COMPARISON OF ANNUAL PERFORMANCE 2020 VS. 2019






COLOMBO TEA AUCTION ELEVATION-WISE PRICE MOVEMENT 2018-2020

PRICE MOVEMENT : HIGH GROWN - 2018 TO 2020





PRICE MOVEMENT : LOW GROWN - 2018 TO 2020






PRICE MOVEMENT : OVERALL - 2018 TO 2020





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SRI LANKA TEA EXPORTS 2010 TO 2020





SRI LANKA TEA EXPORTS – JANUARY TO DECEMBER 2020/2019 COUNTRY-WISE



INTRODUCTION

SRI LANKA MACROECONOMIC UPDATE - 2020

The year 2020 will perhaps be known globally as the year of the Corona virus. All countries were impacted significantly by the Covid-19 pandemic, with Sri Lanka being no exception. Even the global high-income countries suffered negative growth ranging from minus 4.27% (USA) and minus 6% (Germany) to minus 9.76% (UK). Consequent to the economically crippling lockdown which wiped out economic activity in the country from late March to around early June, Sri Lanka posted a negative 3.6% growth for the year. The impact on some of the global lower middle-income countries has been less than the high-income countries, indicative of the control of the Covid-19 pandemic in those countries.

Economic Growth:

Sri Lanka's GDP has contracted 3.6% in 2020, down from a growth of 2.3% in 2019 amidst the Corona virus pandemic. All sectors showed negative growth in the year, with the Industry Sector showing the worst performance, declining 6.9% from a positive 2.6% in 2019.

Positively, the quarterly growth rates show a slow recovery from the steep decline in Q2 of 2020. The industry Sector, which declined 23.1% in Q2, later recovered to show growths of 0.6% and 1.3% in Q3 and Q4 respectively.

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The growth in the agriculture sector has seen many fluctuations over the past 10 years, with a high of 5.8% achieved in 2018 and a low of (negative) 3.7% in 2016. This high and low trend has resulted in the country achieving a total cumulative growth of 17.5% from 2011 to 2020, with the period from 2016 being disastrous for the Agriculture Sector. With the decline in 2020, we have declined to the level of GDP we had in 2015.

Exports:

Sri Lanka exports in 2020 amounted to USD 10,076.9 Million. This was USD 1,862.24 Million below the 2019 exports of USD 11,939.14 Million. This negative growth of over 15.6% was mainly from Q2 of 2020 where exports shrank by 38% over Q2 of the previous year.

The Export Sector of the country has shown a negative growth of 4% over the past 5 years and the Agriculture Sector has performed the worst, showing negative growth in all but one year during the past 5 years.



Inflation:

Inflation as measured by the movement in the National Consumer Price Index (NCPI) was 4.6% in December 2020 (6.2 % in December 2019) with the annual average as at the end December 2020 being 6.2% (3.5% in 2019). It is observed that inflation in 2019 which began at 1.2% in January 2019 ended the year at over 6%, while in 2020 the trend was reversed where the inflation declined from 7.6% in January to 4.6% by December.

The NCPI was updated with 2013 kept as the base year and we have now seen a cumulative 41.2% increase in prices. It is to be noted that years 2017 & 2019 are the highest contributors to this increase.

Debt & Interest Rates:

The country debt default risk was also seen as very high by all major rating agencies with Fitch, S&P and Moody's downgrading the country's bonds. However, Sri Lanka settled or rolled over its liabilities on time even after the year end and at the time of reporting. Nevertheless, the country rating is below that of its peers.

The borrowing by the Central Bank as at 30th November 2020 was Rs. 14,817 Billion. This was made up as follows – Rs. 8,424 Billion (local) and Rs. 6.393 Billion (foreign) sources. This was an increase of Rs. 1,786 Billion from a year ago. Also note that the rupee borrowing increases over the period of time with the devaluation of the currency.

However, despite low ratings by the international agencies, interest rates in the country declined in 2020 against 2019. The benchmark AWPLR declined significantly over the past 12 months to virtually unprecedented levels. We have, therefore, seen an over 50% reduction in interest rates in the country in the short span of 15 months.


The Sri Lankan Rupee (LKR) depreciated against the Sterling Pound, Russian Rouble, Ukraine Hryvnia and the Japanese Yen during the year. However, it appreciated against some of the other major tea importing country currencies.

MARKET OUTLOOK FOR 2021



In projecting a possible market scenario, the following needs due consideration.

- As many tea producer countries continue to promote ‘tea drinking,’ the percentage of tea retained in producer countries have increased quite significantly over the last decade, resulting in a declining availability for exports.
- Tea consumption continues to be dominated by Asian countries, particularly India and China, which together is estimated to be 55% and more of global demand.
- Out of home consumption, which was adversely impacted due to Covid-19 is likely recover to some extent in 2021, particularly as the year progresses.
- Weak market outlook from European countries following the economic downturn, which is unlikely to impact tea prices in a significant manner.
- Uncertainty about US trade policy towards China poses a risk to tea sales. It is hoped that US policy will become less combative with the political change.
- Oil prices moved higher during the first two weeks of December based on stronger Asian demand, effective OPEC+ supply management and positive news on the vaccine front, whilst Brent oil crossed USD 50 for the first time since March.

● From a Sri Lankan perspective, it is most likely that the Sri Lankan Rupee would weaken once the imports on non-essential items are relaxed and in such circumstances, would augur well for Rupee tea prices.

● Sri Lankan tea output although is likely to recover in 2021, is unlikely to achieve the highs registered from 2010 to 2015. Therefore, the supply situation would continue to remain tight.

From a global perspective, tea production in 2020 is likely to record a deficit reflecting the crop shortfall primarily from India, Sri Lanka and China to a lesser extent. Kenya, on the other hand, has recorded a fairly significant increase year-on-year, perhaps reflecting a cyclical recovery after a drought induced decline in 2019. Further, black tea production growth over a period of time has essentially been from the African Region, consisting mainly of CTC teas. From an Orthodox perspective, Sri Lanka as a prime supplier together with India and Vietnam have experienced a crop shortfall in recent times.

In the absence of a global measure of tea stocks, predicting tea prices becomes a near impossibility. Therefore, if the supply and demand equation would be a deciding factor, it would be reasonable to assume that prices in respect of Large Leaf Orthodox teas would sustain at these levels, perhaps even as a worse case scenario. However, prices for Orthodox Rotovane (Small Leaf liquoring teas) would largely weigh on the recovery of tea production in North India, which is unlikely to be regularised during the 1st quarter of 2021 as almost all producer countries experience dry weather conditions and often is a lean cropping period.

At the time of compiling this report, with the 1st quarter of 2021 almost coming to an end, it is evident for tea prices to have strengthened further in rupee terms. A combination of factors – low inventory levels (particularly importers of orthodox teas), improved seasonal teas from the Western slopes and the weakening Sri Lankan Rupee.

From a Sri Lankan perspective, production levels during the 1st quarter of 2021 have been better than anticipated. Therefore, as the supply situation improves, prices into the 2nd quarter are likely to take a correction from the current all-time high rupee prices as some of the key importer countries continue to be burdened with economic downturns.

In this backdrop, the industry continues to be challenged with constant wage increases and lower rates of mechanisation, which would continue to undermine the competitiveness due to higher average production costs than other large producer/exporter countries.

CROP & WEATHER REPORT & QUALITY FOR 2020

1ST QUARTER-2020

Weather

Bright weather was reported for the most parts of the quarter on all planting districts whilst several spells of evening were reported towards the latter part of the quarter.

Crop

Low crop intake were reported on all planting districts during the 1st quarter.

Quality

From the start, a good range was available, and as the weather improved and temperature variations in the climate increased during February and early March, a good variety of Dimbula seasonal quality teas were made from Talawalakelle, Bogawantala, Upcot Maskeliya & Lindula Planting Districts. Overall quality was erratic in the final few weeks of the quarter. Nuwara-Eliyas too followed a similar pattern. Uva and Udapussellawa regions were irregular. A fair selection of Low Grown teas was available during the early part of the quarter and continued to improve towards the latter part of the quarter.

2ND QUARTER-2020

Weather

Clear mornings and wet evenings were experienced throughout the quarter in all planting regions during the quarter.

Crop

Improved crop intake was recorded when compared to the first quarter. However, crop intake was still lower when compared to the same period last year.

Quality

All planting districts, including low grown, were erratic and of lower quality during the period due to heavy evening rainfall and improved crop intake.

3RD QUARTER-2020

Weather

Bright weather was reported in the beginning of the quarter on all planting districts whilst dull & rainy weather was reported towards the latter part.

Crop

Moderate to Increased crop intake was reported during the course of the 3rd quarter.

Quality

In the first two months of the quarter, Westerns were mostly sporadic and lower, but they began to improve toward the end. Following the quality season, Nuwara Eliya's showcased a range of improved teas at the start of the quarter whilst the following two months, the quality deteriorated and was inconsistent. Uva/Udapussellawa's followed a similar pattern, improving at the start of the quarter with seasonal consistency and becoming more erratic as the quarter progressed. The low grown quality maintained during the quarter.

4TH QUARTER-2020

Weather

Clear weather was reported in the beginning of the quarter on all planting districts, However bright mornings with evening showers were experienced during the rest of the quarter.

Crop

Increased crop intake was reported during the 4th quarter on all planting districts.

Quality

The Westerns and Uva/Uda Pussellawa regions had inconsistently lower quality. However, the Nuwara Eliyas', which started out irregular and low in quality, improved in the second half of the quarter, especially on the liquor leafy teas produced. The low grown quality which maintained during the beginning of the quarter began to decline towards the latter part of the quarter.




